Parking is limited as the hay field will not be cut yet, so please "trailer pool" as much as you can. We will schedule you and your traveling companion(s) or coaches' students close together.

Entries close March 23, 2010. Entries limited to 60 rides determined by date of entry. Full payment required with entry form and signed release. Refunds in full before closing date. NO REFUNDS after closing date unless your ride time can be filled. Riding times will be e-mailed and posted on [www.wcdea.org](http://www.wcdea.org) ASAP after deadline. Helmets and appropriate riding shoes/boots are required. Schooling equipment allowed for horse and rider. Indoor warm-up arena is full size with hog fuel footing. Outdoor is full size with sand/rubber footing.
